

M-ERA.NET Evaluators for Call 2021

[M-ERA.NET](#) is currently looking for experts for the evaluation of the full-proposals which will be submitted to the [M-ERA.NET](#) Call 2021.

Registrations will be possible until the end of October. The registration can be done directly via our webpage: <https://www.m-era.net/joint-calls/evaluator-registration>.

Evaluation

The [M-ERA.NET](#) Call 2021 is a 2-stage-procedure. In the 2nd stage full-proposals will be centrally evaluated by international independent experts. Each project will be evaluated by 3 independent experts. Three individual assessments will be compiled by one of the three experts acting as the rapporteur. The compilation will consist of a peer review report (PRR) and allocated scores. The two other experts will receive the compilation and will have, together with the third evaluator, acting as the rapporteur, the possibility for online discussions to agree on the peer review report and scoring. In order to be a potential evaluator for Call 2021, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be available for online individual assessment between 24 November 2021 and end of January 2022 (the deadline to submit the individual assessment reports is on the 22 December 2021)
- Accept to evaluate between 3 and 7 projects,
- Accept to sign the “declaration for [M-ERA.NET](#) evaluation” (including a non-disclosure agreement, notify [M-ERA.NET](#) in case of conflict of interest, agree to deliver assessments in due time and agree that your contact details will be provided to the other 2 involved evaluators per proposal for online discussions during the compilation phase).
- Be available as rapporteur for compiling 3 individual assessments per project (peer review report and scoring) to be delivered online by 12 January 2022 (no physical panel meeting).

After completing the evaluation duties the [M-ERA.NET](#) call secretariat will reimburse 200 € per evaluated proposal (including rapporteur task and efforts for PRR).
